In the registries carried out by brother of land mafia Vivek Jain

Raises eyebrows towards likely nexus with Patwari and Registrar office

Kawardha, Mar 15:

The disclosure of registries with incomplete documents and false information by the Sarafa trader 'brothers' with nexus of the Patwari and Registrar in the Kawardha district is being reported for last few days. At one place where each and every document of a poor land owner is checked thoroughly and that of the land-mafia and their family members they become silent spectators and surrender completely before them! Even after reports in this regard for last few days, the local administration is not taking any action in this regard so far and the same is now raising eyebrows.

In the last 15-20 years in the registries in the Registrar office, be it the land-mafia, Patwari or the employees of the Registrar office, who have been getting fresh posting and transfer, but it is the Sarafa trader, land mafia, who with nexus of Patwari and Registrar, are reportedly involved in removal of names from government land (nazul) without any signature or name on the cheques. In the land pur-

chase by Vivek Jain, brother of Land Mafia Pankaj Jain, the registry was done in June 2020 for Rs 16.50 lakh and both the cheques in the registry are not bearing the name of purchaser. The registry has been done with help of two blank cheques of Rs 8.25 lakh. What is surprising here is that the Dy. Registrar has not even found it appropriate to check the documents enclosed with the registry papers.

It is notable here that in the boundary of the land purchase by Vivek Jain near the 'Lal Talab', there is mention of 'Lal Talab', but there is no mention of the Nazul land bearing Kh. No. 379 between Lal-Talab and Vivek's land and this is not possible without the help of the then Patwari!

The question here is as to why the Dy. Registrar and the Patwaris are so favourable and blind-folded towards land

mafia and their family members. The chances of registry without proper defining of direction of a particular plot or piece of land can be done without signature or name in one or two cases of registries, but keeping the cheques without signature or names in all the registries of the land mafia or their family members, gives rise to many speculations and wrong-doings or a part of well-defined conspiracy. If the EOW conducts inquiry or check footage on CCTV cameras into the sales and purchase of gold and silver jewellery of these sarafa traders and their relatives and land-mafia, then there are chances of many surprising revelations in it.

Collector reviews implementation of govt schemes

Koriya, Mar 15:

In the weekly deadline meeting held here under the chairmanship of District Collector Vinay Kumar Langeh, the operation of government schemes in the district was reviewed. In the meeting, the Collector took information from the District Education Officer regarding the implementation of the Chief Minister's School Jatan Yojana, as under this scheme, the school buildings which need renovation, proper improvements have to be made to provide infrastructure for better education to the

**children.**

The Collector has given instructions to the concerned to ensure necessary repairs and improvements while working according to the rules under the scheme. Under the governments ambitious Godhan Nyaya Yojana, purchase of cow dung in Gauthans, manufacture of

vermicompost and review of purchase by agriculture and allied departments and farmers organizations were also done.

The Collector also instructed to coordinate with Krishi Vigyan Kendra for the sale of products made from cow urine, Jeevamrit and

other organic pesticides. Aadhaar updation and camp for making Ayushman card being organized in the district and in the meeting the Collector has appealed to the general public to take advantage of the camp. He has given necessary instructions to the CEO, District Panchayat, Health

Department, Chief Municipal Officer and all concerned officials.

In view of the summer season, he directed the officials of the Public Health Engineering Department present in the meeting to make necessary preparations so that there is no problem of drinking water. He also directed the CEO Jampad Panchayat to present the list of villages which are inaccessible during the rainy season. CEO District Panchayat Namrata Jain, Joint Collector Anil Sidar, all SDMs and district level officers were present in the meeting.

Resident's protest at Byaguda toll plaza



Bhond, Mar 15: Under the leadership of district member and youth leader Nila Kashyap, hundreds of residents of Bastar burnt the effigy of Union Transport Minister Nitin Gadkari protesting against the toll plaza in Byaguda. They have alleged that taxes are being taken in the name of roads and lights in the toll plazas, but neither the road maintenance work is being done nor the lights are on in the national highway. Nilay Kashyap told that tax is collected in the name of arrangement in the toll plaza, but the National Highway has failed to provide facilities on the National Highway, only the work of recovery is being done by them. A memorandum was also submitted to Bastar SDM Om Prakash Verma by hundreds of Bastar residents. Meanwhile the SDM told that the road has to be repaired, high masks etc. have to be repaired, and the general public of Bhanpuri Bastar has been demanding for 9-10 months to repair the lights there, after which we gave notice to NHI three times. After that no action was taken by them, after which the general public gave a memorandum today that toll collection should not be done until we get the facility from the toll plaza. Unpleasant incidents should not

happen and people have been ordered to seal the toll plaza till further orders for the purpose of maintaining peace. No recovery of any kind will happen in the toll plaza till further orders. During this, Dharma Padhi, Mosu Baghel, Bablu Baghel, Sondhar Baghel, Mayur Nayak, Damru Kashyap, Pintu Yadav, Dukaru, Kameshwar, Chhotu Choubey, Manish Kashyap and others were present.

Hindrance in wage work due to technical fault

Dongargarh, Mar 15: Due to a technical fault in the MNREGA app, before the commencement of MNREGA wage work, cases of laborers returning without work has come to the fore. Regarding which the panchayat representatives have submitted a memorandum to the district collector and higher officials through SDM Dongargarh. The matter pertains to MNREGA work going on in Chhindijob, Bagatola, Ramji Tola and Bodra Tola villages under Gram Panchayat Bor Talav, in which earth work is to be done for road construction from Bortlav to Chhindijob, Bagatola to Mata Devala and Ramji Tola to Bodra Tola. Due to



technical fault in the MNREGA app, the attendance of laborers was not recorded after the laborers arrived at the workplace for the work, due to which the work could not be started and in such a situation, the Panchayat representatives are facing the anger of the workers. A situation of dispute is being created by the laborers with the panchayat representatives regarding the payment of wages. In the memorandum given

to the SDM, the sarpanch and panchayat representatives of the gram panchayat told that the master roll has been issued for the commencement of work from March 9 to March 15, but due to technical fault in online attendance, the work could not be started. In such a situation, the demand has been made by the panchayat representatives to close the MNREGA app and register attendance in the muster roll.
