Deputy Speaker of Chhattisgarh, Manoj Singh Mandavi, dies

CHHATTISGARH ASSEMBLY'S Deputy Speaker and ruling Congress MLA Manoj Singh Mandavi died Sunday following a heart attack, party leaders said.

Mandavi, 58, was taken to a hospital in neighbouring Dhamtari town after he suffered a heart attack where he died in the morning, state Congress communication wing head Sushil Anand Shukla said.

As a mark of respect, the Chhattisgarh government announced one-day state mourning on Sunday in his home district Kanker and capital city Raipur, public relations department officer said.

The national flag will be flown at half mast at these two places during the period. Besides, there will be no government entertainment and cultural programmes during this period there, he added.

A three-time MLA and a prominent tribal face of the party in Bastar region, Mandavi had also served as the minister of state for home and prisons.

'INDIAN LANGUAGES GETTING MORE IMPORTANCE'

Shah launches Hindi medical textbooks, hails PM's vision

LAUNCHING TEXTBOOKS written in Hindi for MBBS students, Union Home Minister Amit Shah said at a function in Bhopal on Sunday that in accordance with Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision, Indian languages are now being given more importance.

As part of the Madhya Pradesh government's project to provide medical education in Hindi, Shah launched Hindi textbooks for anatomy, biochemistry and physiology for first-year MBBS students.

Shah said that Modi is changing "brain drain" into "brain gain" by enabling students to pursue medical and technical education in Hindi and other regional languages.

Addressing the hundreds of students who attended the event, Shah emphasised the significance of the introduction of Hindi textbooks for medical education, and called it a moment of reawakening and reconstruction in the field of education in the country.

"Prime Minister Modi has embarked on a mission of providing medical and engineering education in all languages, including Hindi, Marathi, Tamil, Telugu, Gujarati, Malayalam, Bengali. As per the Prime Minister's vision, our languages are being given importance, and

entrance for medical colleges held through NEET (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test), entrance for engineering through JEE (Joint Entrance Examination), and those in undergraduate courses are being conducted in 12 languages," he said.

Shah congratulated Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan, saying that he has taken the lead in fulfilling the PM's vision by providing medical education in Hindi.

"Every man's thinking process is in their mother tongue, and therefore, as Nelson Mandela had said, 'If you talk to someone in a language, it reaches their brain. But if you talk to the person in their mother tongue, it reaches the person's heart,'" he said.

He also accused those interested in promoting English of

wrongly attributing English to intellectual ability.

Chief Minister Chouhan said students from socially and economically weaker backgrounds were being adversely affected by the teaching of engineering and medicine in English.

"Work for introducing education in Hindi should have been done immediately after Independence. Those who had the responsibility of running the government after Independence, they sinned by making India used to the language of the colonisers. It led to a thought process that without English, one cannot be successful. These people (post-Independence governments) had English in their heart, mind and soul. They created an environment where speaking English will get you respect," Chouhan said.

Minister lays foundation for Gwalior airport expansion

UNION HOME Minister Amit Shah, who on Sunday laid the foundation stone for the new terminal building and expansion of the Rajmata Vijayaraje Scindia Airport in Gwalior city, took aim at the Congress party, saying its previous government in Madhya Pradesh had stopped all pro-pro schemes.

"Madhya Pradesh had once experienced Congress rule, which stopped all pro-pro schemes. Now, the elections are near. Don't repeat the same mistake. Believe in (Prime Minister Narendra) Modi and vote for the BJP," Shah said after laying the foundation stone for the Rs 446-crore expansion of the airport and launching a Rs 4,300-crore project under the Jal Jeevan Mission.

After a debacle in the panchayat elections in the Gwalior-Chambal region, the BJP has launched mega projects in the region to woo voters.

Shah appealed to the people to re-elect the BJP government in Madhya Pradesh, which is going to polls in November, next year.

Day after his killing, Kashmiri Pandit cremated in Jammu

A DAY after his killing by militants near his house at Chowdhary Gund in Kashmir's Shopian, Puran Krishan Bhat—a Kashmiri Pandit who has lived in the Valley even during periods of militancy in the past three decades—was cremated in Jammu amid a feeling of anger and despair among the Pandit community.

Except for a few slogans against Pakistan and Kashmir Divisional Commissioner Pandurang Pole, there were no signs of protest by members of the Kashmiri Pandit community, even though many were visibly angry and there were rumblings of discontent against the administration.

The Valley started witnessing a new wave of attacks mainly targeting migrant workers after the abrogation of Article 370 in 2019.

Militants started targeting Kashmiri Pandits from last year with the killing of prominent businessman M.L. Bindroo who was shot at his medical store in Srinagar in October. Since then, Puran Bhat is the fourth Kashmiri Pandit to be killed. On May 12 this year, militants shot Rahul Bhat inside the revenue office where he worked in Budgam. On August 18, militants killed Sunil Kumar and injured Paitamber Kumar inside an orchard in Shopian.

The killing of Rahul Bhat, who was appointed under the Prime Minister's Relief and Rehabilitation Package for Kashmiri Pandits, triggered largescale protests from employees under the scheme who demanded a transfer to Jammu. The attacks also prompted administration to shift several employees to relatively safer locations.

A Kashmiri Pandit employees' leader, Rubon Saproo, said that de-

spite the protests, the Divisional Commissioner has made biometric attendance of staff necessary in all offices in Kashmir.

Sensing the mood, senior BJP leaders stayed away from attending Bhat's cremation.

Bhat was among the few Kashmiri Pandits who stayed back in the Valley even during the peak militancy period. Bhat, who owned an apple orchard in Shopian, returned just 15-20 days ago after spending nearly a month with his family in Jammu. He is survived by his wife Sweety, 41, daughter Shreya, 11, and son Shanu, 8. The apple orchard is the family's only source of livelihood.
