

Lawyers' protest turns ugly near court, as they misbehave with common people

The lawyers staged a protest in front of the court on Tuesday demanding the arrest of the accused in Bhopal who attacked Advocate Dipesh Sharma.

During the protest, the lawyers scuffled with the commuters. The female lawyer slapped the woman passing by the road. The woman tried to attack by pulling her hair. A youth coming out of the scooty was also beaten up. The police remained on the watch. For half an hour, the lawyers continued to create ruckus on the road.

Colony Tilajmalpura, is a lawyer by profession. They were coming towards Hamidia Hospital via Fatehgarh Road on Friday evening at 7 pm. At the same time, two youths riding

started abusing Dipesh. A young man attacked Dipesh with a knife in which he suffered serious injuries in the attack.

Till now the accused has not been arrested. In protest against this, the lawyers staged a protest in front of the court on Tuesday. During this, people were passing through the road, who were beaten up by the lawyers. District Bar Association president PC Kothari was also present in the demonstration.

After the video of assault with passersby came to the fore, District Bar Association President PC Kothari said that the woman was not assaulted.

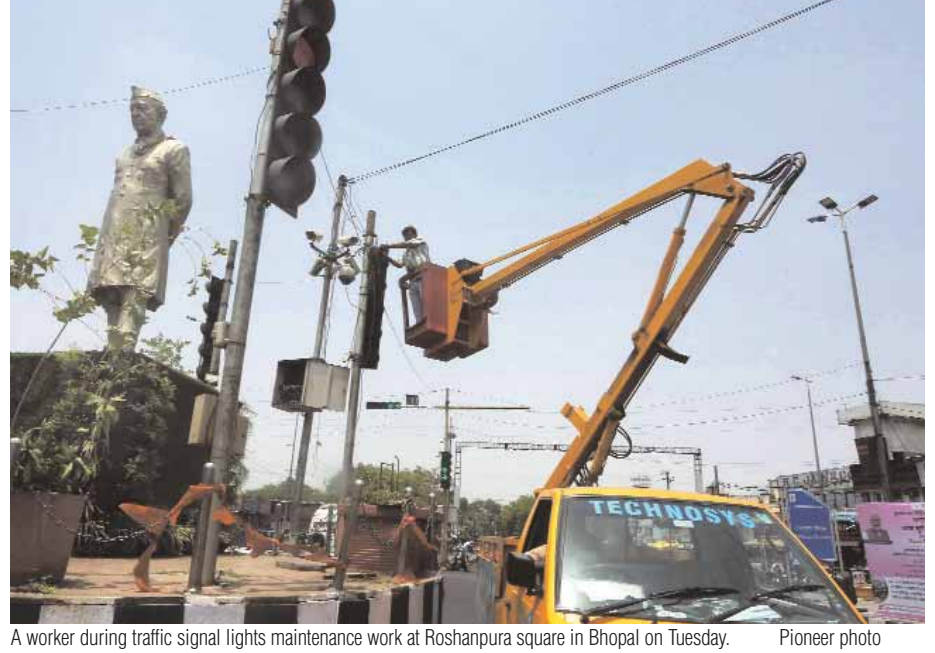
Motivate to adopt Anganwadis: CM

Nomination process for three vacant Rajya Sabha seats commences

With the issuance of the notification of biennial election to fill the three vacant seats for Rajya Sabha from Madhya Pradesh, the nomination process for these three seats has started.

For this election, Principal Secretary of Madhya Pradesh Vidhan Sabha Awadhesh Pratap Singh has been appointed as Returning Officer and Additional Secretary BD Singh as Assistant Returning Officer. The polling place has been authorized. Tadashay notification has been released by the Returning Officer today.

It is noteworthy that elections are to be held for three Rajya Sabha seats falling vacant from Madhya Pradesh. The tenure of Rajya Sabha

members Vivek Krishna Tankha, Sampatiya Uikey and M.J. Akbar is ending on June 29, 2022.

The process of election for the above three seats of Rajya Sabha will start from May 24, 2022 and will continue till June 13, 2022. During this period from 24 to 31 May, 2022 every day (except on public holidays) from 11:00 am to 3:00 pm, office of the Returning Officer, Rajya Sabha Election, 2022 Committee Room No. -2 can be presented. Scrutiny of nomination papers will be done from 1st June, 2022 at 2:00 PM. The time for withdrawal of nominations is fixed on 3rd June, 2022 till 3:00 PM.

If necessary, the voting will be held on 10th June, 2022 from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM, after which the counting of votes will be completed.

Ensure strict control on criminal elements: Chief Minister

Bhopal: Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan has said that the review on implementation of public welfare schemes should be conducted regularly.

The minister in charge should be apprised about the progress of works in the review meeting every month. Chouhan said that the Amrit Sarovars being built in the year 'Azadi ka

Amrit Mahotsav" should be made a place of inspiration for patriotism. The work of creating an environment of social harmony should be done by the administration in the districts. There should be communication with all classes.

There should be no incidents of caste hatred and religious conversion. Criminal elements

should be strictly controlled. Incidents of illegal liquor sale, gambling, betting, theft and other crimes should be checked at any cost. Realize the possibilities of development through public participation. Chouhan was reviewing the schemes run in Mandasaur and Jhabua districts through video conferencing from his residence on Tuesday.

New heights should be given to health services

Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan has said that along with infrastructural development in the field of health, the campaign to increase health awareness should also be intensified. Give new heights to health services in the state. Voluntary cooperation should be obtained from competent persons to improve the hospitals. Donating to health institutions and having public participation also creates an emotional connection towards them. Set an example by changing the look and feel of health institutions in the next few months. Chouhan said this after the presentation of the action plan prepared by the Public Health and Family Welfare Department in Mantralaya today. Public Health and Family Welfare Minister Prabhuram Choudhary, Chief Secretary Iqbal Singh Bains and Health Commissioner Sudam Khade were present. ACS Health Mohammad Suleman gave a presentation. It was informed in the presentation that efforts are

being made to develop new treatment services for dialysis and cancer disease in the state. The focus is on strengthening the arrangements of medicines, testing services, blood banks and storage in health institutions, expansion of telemedicine and development of beneficiary facilities. CT scan test facility is being made available in all the district hospitals of the state. At present this facility is available in 45 district hospitals. Soon this facility will also be available in the hospitals affiliated to 3 medical colleges. Similarly, the sonography test facility is also expanding. Facility of state-of-the-art digital radiography X-ray machine has also been made available. This work is also expanding. Central Pathology Lab is being operated in all district hospitals and civil hospitals with capacity of more than 100 beds.

There are 132 types of tests in these. The number of dialysis machines in district hospitals is also being increased so that patients do not have to wait for dialysis. At present 222 dialysis machines are installed in district hospitals.

Beds have been reserved in district hospitals for day-care, chemotherapy and palliative care. Necessary training has also been given to strengthen cancer services. Arrangements have been made to take tele-consultation from specialist doctors in primary health centres through the PPP model. Help desks will be set up continuously to assist the patients and family members. Main instructions of the Chief Minister- * Increase efforts to address maternal health challenges and anaemia control. People's representatives should also be involved in the work of expansion of health facilities. * Messages related to health safety in simple language should be given to the public through printed and digital mediums. * Mandasaur district is moving ahead in improving the sex ratio, where 1021 daughters are being born per 1000 sons. Similar efforts should be made in other districts also. * There should be smooth distribution of medicines from primary health centres to district hospitals.

Power subsidy of Rs 16,424 crore 18 lakh to consumers

The State Cabinet here on Tuesday decided to grant subsidy of Rs16 thousand 424 crore 18 lakhs to consumers under various categories on fixed rates for the financial year 2022-23. This is in addition to the subsidy of Rs. 5,584 crore 40 lakh approved under the Griha Jyoti Yojana for domestic consumers of the state. In lieu of this, subsidy will be given to the power distribution companies.

Total Rs 10,372 crore 17 lakh for subsidy in lieu of being charged flat rate of Rs. 750 per horsepower per year from meterless permanent agricultural consumers with capacity up to 10 horsepower, Rs.690 crore 56 lakh for subsidy in lieu of being charged Rs. 1500 per horsepower per year on flat rate from meterless permanent agricultural consumers with capacity more than 10 horsepower, Rs. 43 crore 45 lakh for metered permanent agricultural pump with capacity up to 10 horsepower and a subsidy of Rs. 2 crore 96 lakh will be given for metered permanent agricultural pump with capacity more than 10 horsepower. Also, decision has been taken to give a subsidy of Rs 193 crore 81 lakh for the combination of a temporary agril-

cultural pump with a capacity of up to 10 horse power, Rs. 12 lakh for a combination of a temporary agricultural pump with a capacity of more than 10 horse power, Rs. 4983 crore 33 lakh for providing free electricity to SC/ST permanent agriculture pump consumers up to 5 horse power with one hectare land and subsidy of Rs 137 crore 77 lakh will be given for exemption from annual minimum charges to high pressure lift/group irrigation consumers and 190 paise per unit in energy charges.

The Cabinet approved the proposal to start three new awards, Madhya Pradesh Gaurav Samman, Chief Minister's Award for Excellence (for outstanding performance in government schemes) and Chief Minister's Award for Excellence (for innovation).

CM plants neem, peepal saplings at Smart city park
